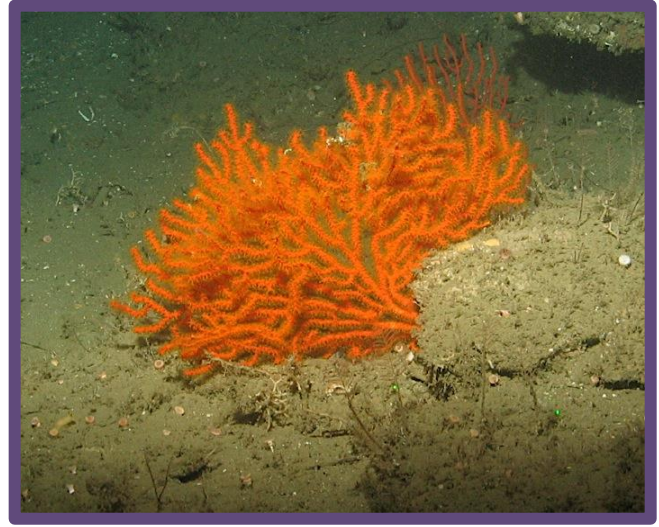

Soft Corals – Sea Fans, Sea Pens, Black Coral



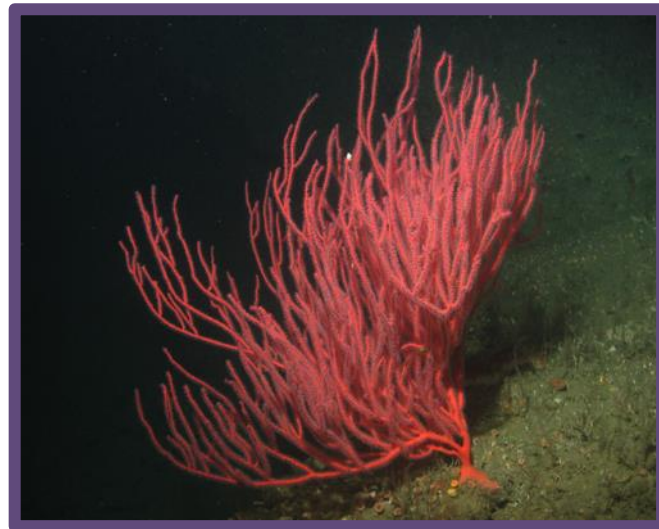
Acanthogorgia - Golden sea fan



Adelogorgia - Orange sea fan



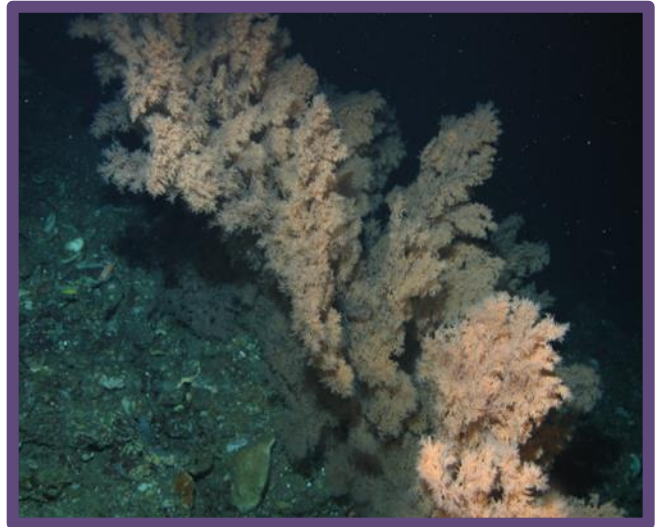
Eugorgia - Purple sea fan



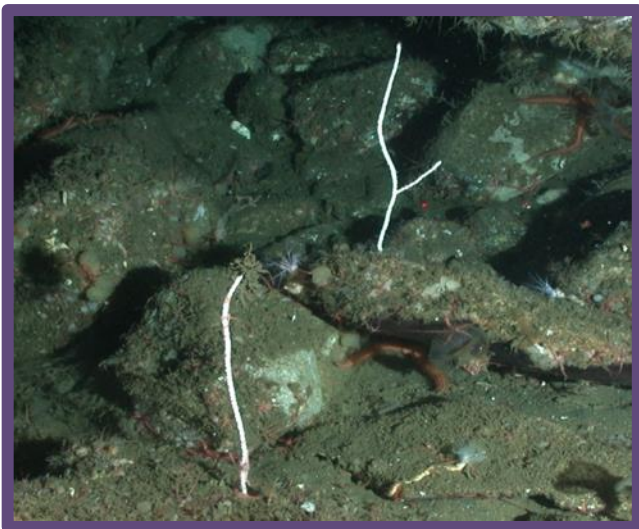

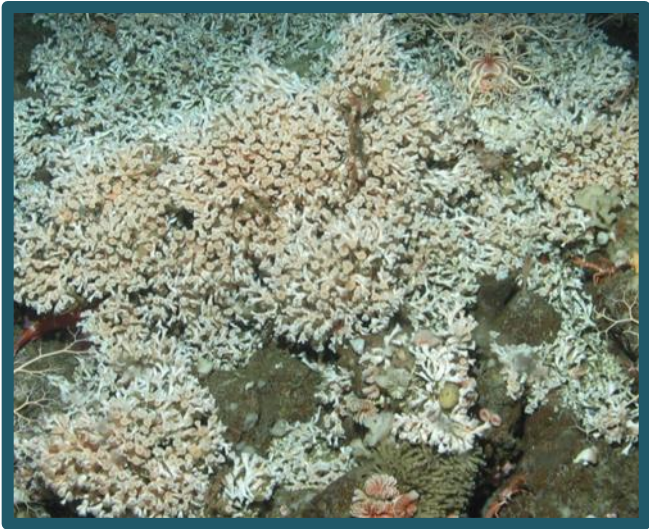

Desmophyllum – Cockscomb cup coral

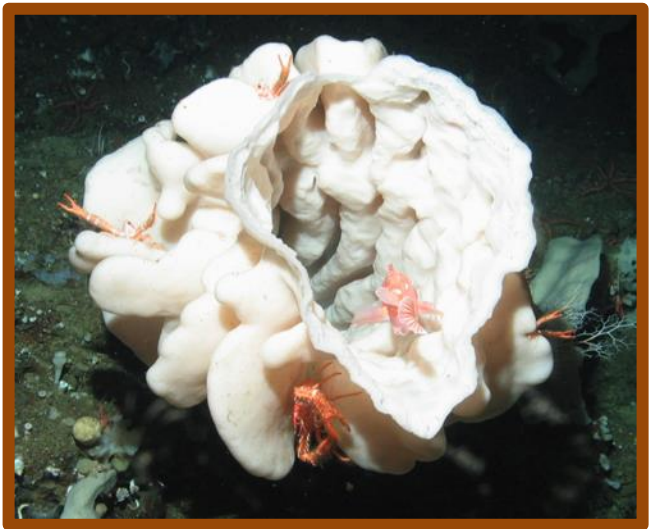


Flabellum – Cup coral

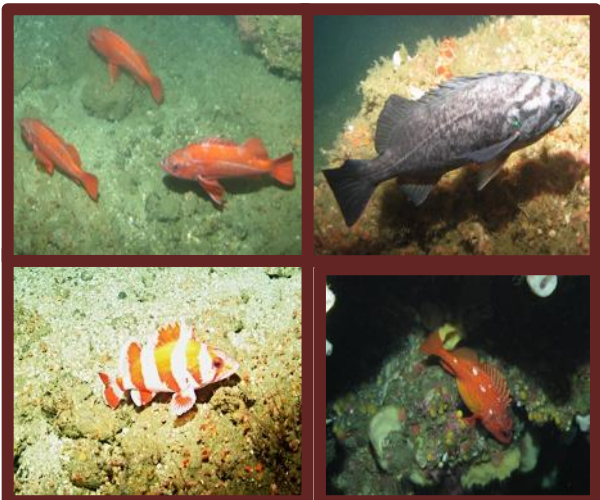

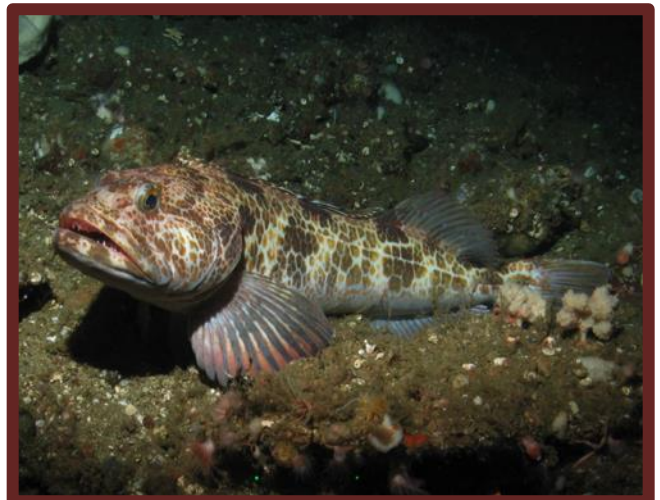

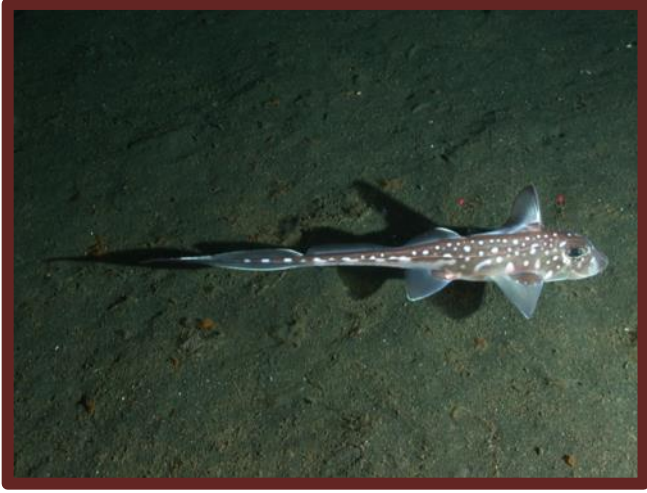
